## -Information on Fishing Area-

● Fishing Period: January 23 to February \_\_\_\_ May be postponed or cancelled depending on the thickness of the ice.

Time: 06:15 AM to 15:00 PM

● Fishing Fee: High school students or older — 600 yen (elementary school students — free)

Junior high school students, 75 years old

or older, disabled -300 yen

Important Notes on Fishing

- 1. You need a fishing ticket to enter the area beyond the temporary office (fishing ticket station).
- Once you are in the fishing area, please follow announcements and instructions from the staff.
- 3. Those fishing are bound to accept full responsibility for any injury that might occur in the fishing area, as well as car accidents, suffocation due to oxygen deficiency inside the tent, etc. Please pay proper attention regarding such hazards.
- Fishing outside the fishing area is prohibited. Please do not approach the prohibited places.
- 5. Fishing holes must be no more than 15cm in diameter and opened at an interval of no less than 50cm.
- 6. Use of charcoal, either in briquettes or lumps, is prohibited.
- 7. Pets (dogs, cats, etc.) are not allowed.
- 8. Use of drones is prohibited.
- No waste containers are available. Please take any waste with you when you leave.
- 10. Please always use only the provided temporary toilets. Please note that they may become out of order or moved to another spot due to snow or ice condition.
- 11. Due to thaw, heavy snow, strong wind or other conditions, fishing may be suspended even after it has started.
- 12. Iwate Prefecture Common Fishing Tickets are not accepted.
